Becoming a Regional Representative

- Regional representatives are appointed by the Board of Directors by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. Individuals serving as a Regional Representative may not simultaneously serve on the Board of Directors and do not have voting rights.
- WAFO's goal is to have one Regional Representative per Wisconsin County (72). Until then, we will ask our representatives to serve WAFO and Wisconsin woodland owners interests in their region to be determined shortly after being appointed by the board.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Support and promote the mission of WAFO by working with local organizations, state agencies and elected officials.
- Keep informed of WAFO activities and local and state activities that affect Wisconsin's woodland owners.
- Attend meetings of the Board of Directors as requested.
- Representatives are encouraged to serve on special committees and participate in programs and activities.
- Attend annual Regional Representative conference.
- Keep WAFO's staff informed of your activities. Staff and board members are happy to support your efforts.

Terms
